Please let me know if you find this document of use.

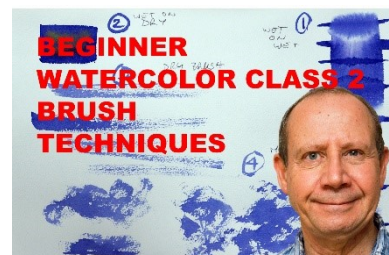

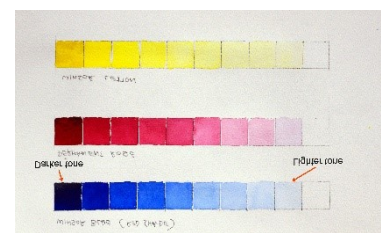

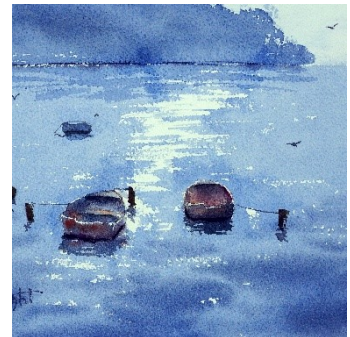

Beginner Watercolor Class 8 - Sunset and Trees

This video covers how to paint clean graded watercolor washes to paint a lovely sunset as well as how to paint trees and shrubs in silhouette. Paper and brush handling, composition, and design are also covered in parts.



Beginner Watercolor Class 9 - Wet-On-Wet

This episode covers the wet-on-wet technique, how to do it, and what to keep in mind to produce the effects you want as a watercolor artist.



Watercolor Class 10 - Old Farm

In this episode I cover the following: How to paint trees and foliage. Mixing greens with watercolor paint. Drawing and painting simple buildings. How to paint rust on roofs.



Watercolor Class 11 - Complementary Colors

In this episode I cover the following: Paint consistency. Color mixing. Mixing complementary colors. The difference between secondary and tertiary colors. This is a great exercise to learn all about mixing tertiary colors by adding secondary colors together. How to grey off colors to add depth to your painting. As in all of this series, colors are limited to just three - Winsor Blue (Red Shade), Permanent Rose, and Winsor Lemon.



Watercolor Course 12 - Lagoon Sunset

In this episode we paint a lovely sunset over a lagoon scene. I focus on teaching you how to mix the right consistency paint, to place at the right place, with the right brush, on paper which is at the right wetness.



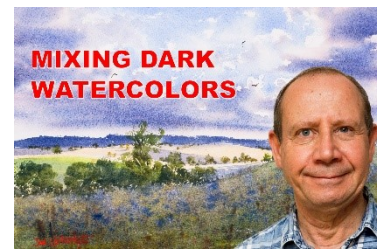
Watercolor Class 13 - Painting Rocks

In this episode I cover 10 techniques to help you paint rocks with watercolor paint. Here are the subjects covered in this video: 1. Light, shadows, and rock form 2. Simple smooth oval rock 3. Sharp edged rocks 4. Creating rock shapes with a credit card 5. Using candle wax to preserve highlights 6. Drizzling water to create great tonal and form transitions 7. Painting grasses near rocks 8. Reflections of rocks 9. Textures on rock surfaces. Dry brush technique 10. Painting masses of rocks easily 11. Multi-colored rocks.



Watercolor Class 14 - Mixing Dark Colors

In this episode I cover 6 topics which look at common beginner mistakes that hinder them from mixing correct tones and colors. I also cover my basic technique to help you start with the correct tones and colors to minimise later adjustments.



Color Mixing Formula - Bright vs Dull Colors

In this video I give you critical information to help you mix clean, bright colors when you want them. I also cover how to mix various greys and where they are important. I aim to clear up confusions people often have about warm and cool colors which cause them to produce unexpected results when they try to mix a particular color. This is particularly true when the target is a bright clean color, but the result is dull and lacking vibrancy. An understanding of the information in this video is very important if you want to predictably mix the color you want quickly.



Drawing and Painting Cows

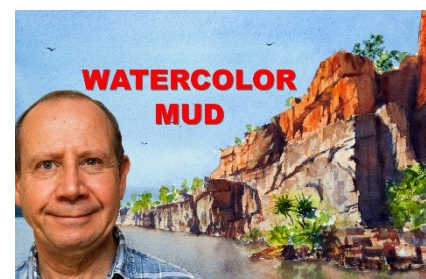
This number 16 in my beginner watercolor painting series.

If you paint farm landscapes, you need to know how to draw and paint simple cows. This is part one of a series on how to draw and paint cows. While the painting is in watercolor, the drawing sections apply to any drawing and painting medium.



How not to create mud

Mud, when talking about watercolor painting refers to a section of the painting which is not smooth and transparent looking. Instead, it looks dull and lifeless. If the paint is not allowed to flow on the paper, you will not see the colors softly merge with one another, which is one of watercolor's beautiful qualities.



Mixing Greens

In this video I cover how to mix greens with watercolors. The topic is also relevant to oil and acrylic painting as well. This video explains the main reasons students often struggle to mix the right green.



Preserving Whites When Painting with Watercolor

In this video I cover 5 techniques for preserving your whites in watercolor paintings.



Beginner Class 20 – Splatter or Spatter Watercolor Technique

Many watercolor artists use splatter (or spatter) techniques to create interesting and useful textures in their paintings. It can be used to add depth to a painting, or texture on old buildings, or just beautiful abstract shapes.



Fog and Mist - Full Demonstration

How to paint fog and mist with watercolors. Watercolor wet-on-wet technique is particularly good for painting fog and mist scenes.



How to use a spray bottle

The correct way to use a spray bottle is critical to keeping your painting at the right moisture level to allow you to paint without creating cauliflowers.



Watercolor Landscape – Full Demonstration

While this painting is based on an Australian landscape, the techniques and information provided can be applied to most landscapes around the world.



Waves Crashing on Rocks with Spray

This is a full watercolor painting demonstration of waves crashing on rocks with large white spray and plenty of foam on the water.

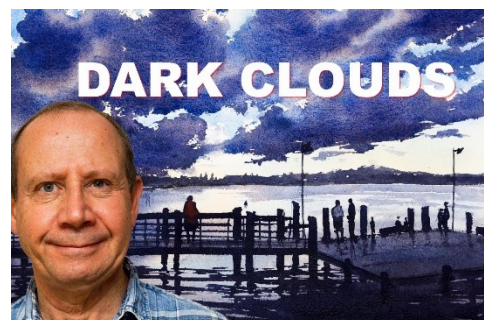


Dark Clouds at Sunset

If you have trouble painting dramatic skies this video is for you.



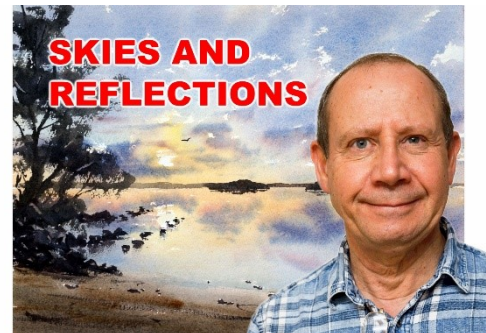
Watercolor Landscape - Full Step by Step

Watercolor painting of skies and reflections. The location of the subject is Port Stephens in NSW, though the real subjects are the sky and reflection.



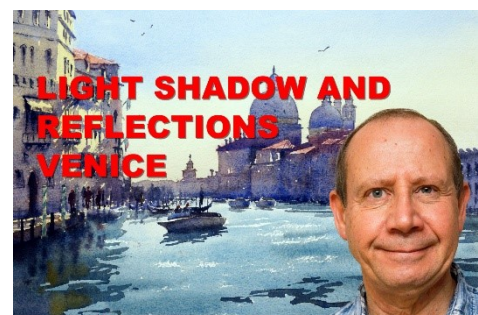
Watercolor Seascape - sea spray, waves, and rocks - Full Demonstration

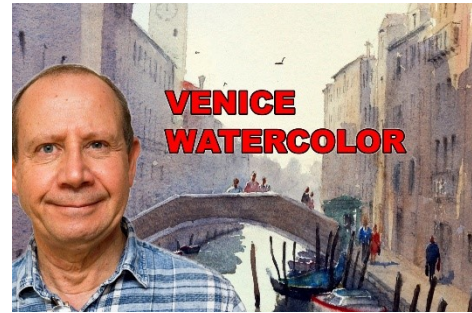
Light, Shadows, Reflections – Venice

Full demonstration watercolor painting of Light, Shadows, and Reflections - Venice.



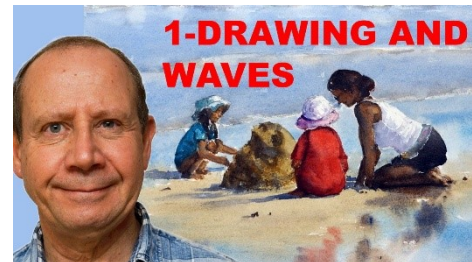
Venice - San Giorgio Dei Greci Full Demonstration

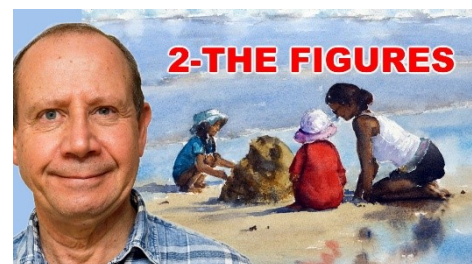
Watercolor painting - Beach fun with mum. Part 1

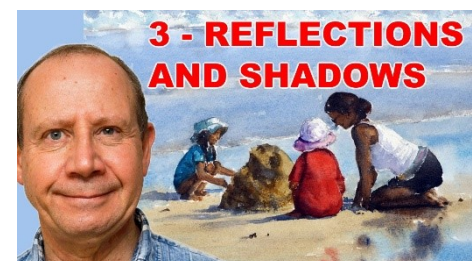
Painting Figures - Beach fun with mum. Part 2

These are my current color, all made by Winsor and Newton. Veridian and Neutral Tint are only used in special cases.



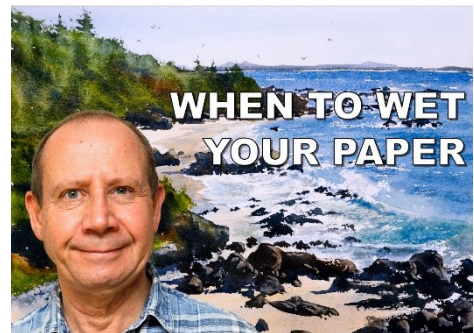

This video gives 20 tips about shadows and how to paint them. Most of the tips apply to all painting mediums, including oil, acrylic, pastel, and watercolor.



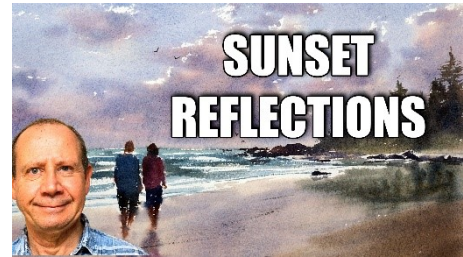
Painting Reflections

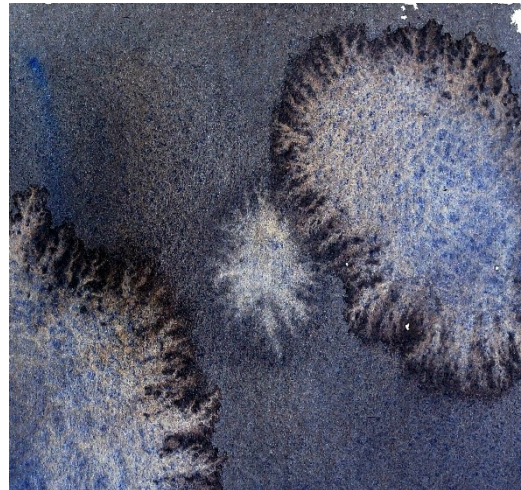

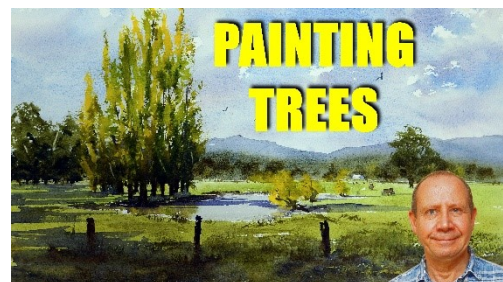

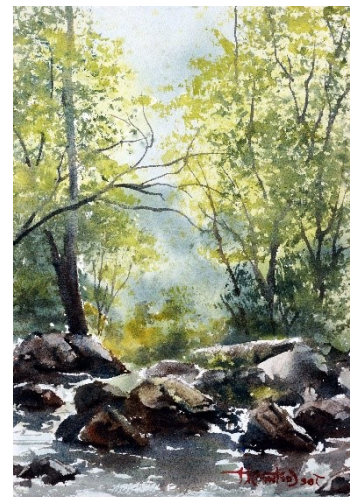

Atmospheric street scene painting

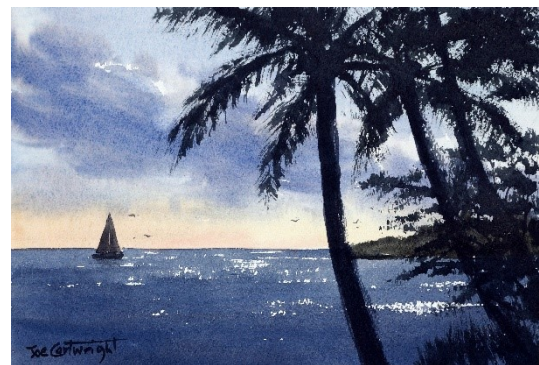

This is the painting stage which focuses on adding atmospheric perspective or aerial perspective to your painting. This is a long video as I believe you should see real live painting steps rather than speeded up versions which don't give you a feel of how fast a painting stage should take.

Topics I cover include how to capture depth and atmosphere in your watercolour street scene painting. Aerial Perspective, buildings, cars, figures, and painting with a limited palette.



Hawaiian sunset and palm trees

In this video I show you how to paint a beautiful sunset sky and palm trees with watercolor. This is a great subject for beginner watercolor artists.



Rocks Above and Under Water - Part One

This is the first part of a three-part video on how to paint rocks above and below water. I will be releasing a new part each week for the next two weeks. There are about 4 hours of viewing time in total for the three videos. For my Patrons I include the full video, with minimal speeded up sections (just the routine parts, like wetting the back of the paper), as it gives you a better feel for just how long certain sections take to do, and so I can explain each section in detail.

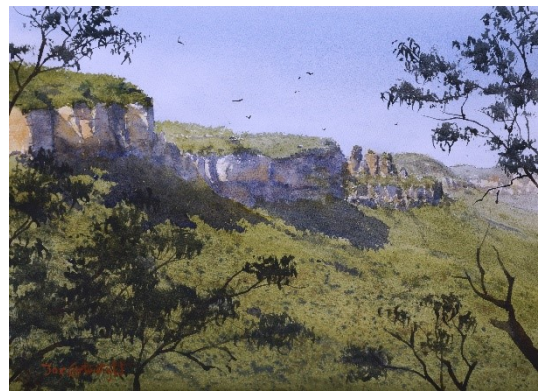

How to paint cliffs and tree covered hills with watercolors

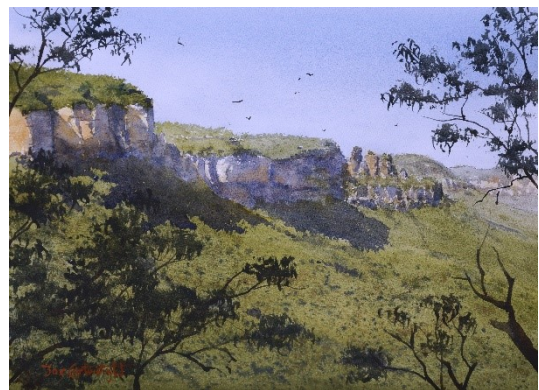

This video teaches you how to cliff faces and tree covered hills with watercolor. How to add depth and atmosphere to a landscape.



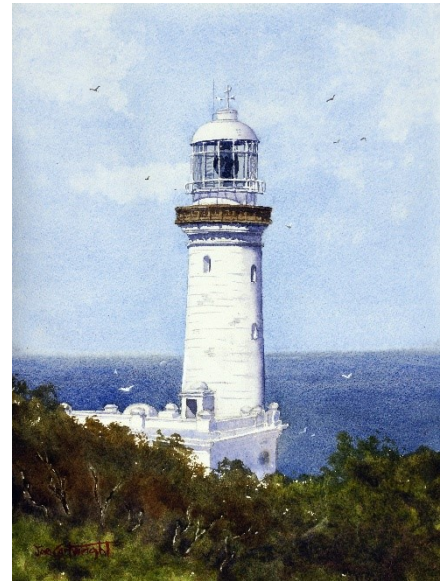

How to paint bright watercolor sunsets

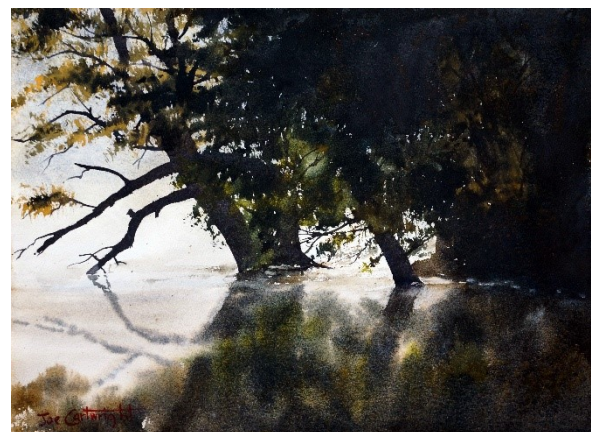
